BY AIR & RAIL

- **Nice Côte d'Azur International Airport** : direct flights to 100+ destinations

THE LÉRINS ARCHIPELAGO

SAINTE MARGUERITE ISLAND

- Swim in **crystal clear water**, notably through **the underwater eco-museum by Jason DeCaires Taylor**

THE LÉRINS ARCHIPELAGO

SAINT-HONORAT ISLAND

- A spiritual haven, home to the **Abbey of Lérins** since the **5th-century**
- UNESCO World Heritage candidate
- Visit the **11th-century abbey and fortified monastery** steeped in history
- Taste the exquisite **organic wines** and liqueurs produced by the monks
- Stroll along paths lined with **pine trees, olive trees, and vineyards**



Fortified Monastery of Saint-Honorat Island (2020-2026)

- Structural consolidation & heritage conservation
