**LA MALMAISON® ART CENTRE, CANNES**

Description: Located in the heart of the Croisette, La Malmaison is one of Cannes' most iconic cultural venues. Formerly an annexe of the prestigious Grand Hôtel, this Belle Époque building has been transformed into a 600 sq. m contemporary art centre spanning three floors, combining historic elegance with contemporary creativity.

Fully renovated, La Malmaison hosts internationally renowned temporary exhibitions throughout the year, showcasing major figures from modern and contemporary art.

Estimated duration: 1 hour

Address: La Malmaison – La Croisette – 06400 Cannes

Opening period and hours:

Tuesday to Sunday: 10 a.m. to 1 p.m. and 2 p.m. to 5 p.m.

Closed: Mondays, 1 November, 11 November, 25 December and 1 January - subject to availability *.

**The centre may be temporarily closed to the public during the transition period between two exhibitions, while exhibitions are being installed or dismantled.*

TRANS CÔTE D'AZUR – BOAT CROSSING TO SAINTE-MARGUERITE ISLAND

Description: Approximately 15-minute boat crossing to Sainte-Marguerite Island.

Departure point: Quai Laubeuf, Port of Cannes.

Opening period and hours:

From 1 October 2026 to 30 April 2027 and from 1 October 2027 to 30 April 2028. Daily - subject to availability.

MUSEUM OF THE MAN IN THE IRON MASK AND THE ROYAL FORT, SAINTE-MARGUERITE ISLAND – SELF-GUIDED VISIT

Description: Discover the state prison and the cell of the Man in the Iron Mask, where the mysterious prisoner was incarcerated for eleven years, as well as Jean Le Gac's murals and underwater and terrestrial archaeological artefacts.

Address: Royal Fort, Sainte-Marguerite Island

BOAT CROSSING WITH PLANARIA & DISCOVER THE ABBEY AND FORTIFIED MONASTERY

After an approximately 15-minute boat crossing, explore Saint-Honorat Island at your own pace, including its Cistercian abbey, chapels, recently restored fortified monastery and vineyards, where the monks still produce exceptional wines according to a centuries-old tradition. *Access to the monastery may incur an additional charge, depending on the period.*

A duo of miniature liqueurs produced by the Cistercian monks of Saint-Honorat Island: discover two artisanal liqueurs made according to the monks' expertise, using carefully selected plants and aromatic herbs. An authentic souvenir perpetuating a centuries-old monastic tradition.
